## Halloween Safety Tips



### Costumes

- Should be short enough to prevent tripping
- Check labels to make sure they are flame resistant
- Add reflective tape to costumes or candy bags
- Do not let children carry prop guns or knives
- Use face paint instead of masks to allow for better vision
- Secure emergency ID information in your child's costume, treat bag or use a necklace or bracelet.

### Trick or Treating

- Carry a flashlight
- Stay in well-lit and familiar neighborhoods
- Eat dinner before trick or treating so you aren't tempted to snack on the goodies before they are checked.
- Do not eat anything that isn't commercially wrapped

### Candy and Treats

- Toss all candy that is unwrapped, homemade or looks like it has been tampered with.

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- Check small toys or novelty items for small parts that could pose a choking hazard.
- Make sure your home is well lit
- Remove obstacles from porch and driveways
- Confine pets
- Don't overload electrical outlets with decorations
- Keep candles and Jack O 'Lanterns in safe places and always under adult supervision.
